4	Fruit that is banned on Singapore's public transport.	DURIAN.
5	Edible snail often served with garlic.	ESCARGOT.
6	Hannibal Lecter likes these with liver and chianti.	FAVA BEANS.
7	A spicy stew from Hungary.	GOULASH.
8	Sauce made from egg yolk, butter and lemon juice.	HOLLANDAISE.
9	Cocktail made from vodka & Pernod or a lettuce.	ICEBERG.
10	A savoury rice dish originating in Louisiana.	JAMBALAYA.
11	Salted and fermented vegetables from Korea.	KIMCHI.
12	Henry I is said to have died from a surfeit of this eel-like fish.	LAMPREY.
13	A cheese from La Mancha in Spain.	MANCHEGO.
14	A traditional Japanese dish made with fermented soybeans.	NATTO.
15	A cocktail made with whisky, bitters and water served on ice.	OLD FASHIONED.
16	This fruit is also known as the 'pawpaw'.	PAPAYA.
17	The Owl and the Pussycat dined on slices of this together with mince.	QUINCE.
18	A mixture of butter and flour or a family of restaurateurs.	ROUX.
19	A cured sausage of fermented and dried meat.	SALAMI.
20	Known as 'Frog Spawn' at school dinners.	TAPIOCA.
21	Technically this fruit is a Jamaican Tangelo.	UGLI FRUIT.
22	Some say its expensive but it's just 'dead deer'.	VENISON.
23	Chinese dumplings that can be savoury or sweet.	WONTON.
24	A natural sugar alcohol found in plants, often used as a sugar substitute.	XYLITOL.
